QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR CALL FROM JESUS:

1. WHAT HAVE YOU LEARNED FROM

JESUS LATELY?

"One day as Jesus was preaching on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, great crowds pressed in on him to listen to the word of God." Luke 5:1 (NLT)

"Simon Peter replied, 'Lord ... You alone have the words that give eternal life. We believe them, and we know you are the Holy One of God.'" John 6:68-69 (NLT)

2. WHAT HAS JESUS RECENTLY

GUIDED YOU TO DO?

"When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Now go out where it is deeper and let down your nets, and you will catch many fish.' 'Master,' Simon replied, 'we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing. But if you say so, we'll try again.' And this time their nets were so full they began to tear! A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking." Luke 5:4-7 (NLT)

3. HOW HAS JESUS SURPRISED YOU ?

"Keep your eyes open for God, watch for his works; be alert for signs of his presence."
Psalm 105:4 (*The Message*)

"When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, 'Oh, Lord, please leave me – I'm too much of a sinner to be around you.' For he was awestruck by the size of their catch, as were the others with him. His partners, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were also amazed." Luke 5:8-10a (NLT)
